This five-day workshop will include a thorough study and explanation of the NHLA Rules Book, emphasizing the basics of hardwood lumber inspection.

This popular workshop gives yardmen, sawyers, edgemen, sales and office staff, and management level personnel an introduction to lumber inspection. Classes will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 4:30 p.m.

This short course will be taught by Benji Richards, NHLA National Inspector.
